Spring planning season is upon us, and it's time to RAMP Up Your School Counseling Program. Join us for this online training event, "RAMP Up Your School Counseling Program," May 6, 13 and 20.

Are a number of schools in your district close to or interested in applying for or learning about the Recognized ASCA Model Program (RAMP)? Attend our three-session online training and help your schools learn what they need to do to put it all together and apply for RAMP.

Based on the ASCA National Model, RAMP is a recognition program for individual schools, not districts or school counselors. Applying for RAMP helps schools evaluate their school counseling program, discover areas for improvement and enhance the program's efforts to contribute to student success.

Karen Griffith, Ph.D., will guide you through the RAMP application requirements and help you understand each section of your school's application. You'll scout out tips and suggestions about how to approach the process and how to submit your RAMP application through the online submission portal.

RAMP training is free for New York state school counselors. Teams from schools are welcomed. Space is limited, so register soon. Program recording will be available to registrants only.

The RAMP application process should be the culmination of the implementation of a data-informed school counseling program. Once a school has a program in place, it will need at least one entire academic year to collect the data and information needed to fulfill the RAMP application requirements.
